Golf Course Rules and Etiquette

- R.C.G.A. rules govern all play
- Keep power carts 30 feet from greens and tees, or on cart path where provided
- To ensure pace of play, keep lost ball search times to a minimum and/or allow faster groups to "play through"
- Respect "natural areas" and avoid entering if possible
- Obey all directional signage
- Alcoholic beverages other than those purchased on site are strictly prohibited
- Do not enter water hazard areas
- Dress code in effect
- Repair ball marks and rake sand traps
- Players may be required to pair with other groups at the Starters discretion
- Course Marshalls and Starters have full authority and persons not abiding by above stated rules will forfeit privileges
- *Drinking water is not provided on golf course, except from beverage cart
